QAR is an academic, international, peer-reviewed publication that approaches the issues of quality assurance in higher education. QAR aims to promote the development of a culture of quality assurance in the Romanian higher education area. The journal also helps to the transfer of good practices and facilitates the communication between experts in the field of quality assurance in higher education. QAR targets those interested in the theory, practice and policies related to the control, management and improvement of quality in higher education.

The editors encourage the submission of research results, especially those that evaluate the impact of quality assurance systems, procedures and methodologies. We also welcome theoretical analyses of quality assurance in higher education and comparative evaluations that focus on identifying methods, systems and quality practices that are transferable.

#### **Topic:**

This issue of QAR will seek to analyse quality practices (curricula, learning process, infrastructure and logistical facilities for teaching, learning and research) regarding the internationalization of educational and research services. Another aspect included in this thematic issue is how the attitude of higher education institutions and the involvement of academic structures have modified due to the process of internationalization of knowledge and research. The editors encourage the submission of articles that analyse, through case-studies, the adaptation of strategies and instruments of quality assurance in the context of increasing internationalization.

### Indications and text formatting requirements:

- Submitted articles should be original and unpublished. Materials that are excessively descriptive will not be accepted.
- The theme of the paper must be presented clearly and the author's perspective should be scientific and detached.
- Submitted articles should be between 5000 and 6000 words in length (bibliography and foot notes included). We may also consider manuscripts which are lengthier, although they may be published sequentially.
- Manuscripts must be accompanied by an abstract. The abstract must have between 100 and 150 words (Times New Roman, 11, *italics*). After each abstract the author must mention the keywords.
- The main working languages of QAR are Romanian and English.
- Main text: Times New Roman, 12, justified, 1.5 lines. Page setup: A4 with 2.54 margins.
- Titles: Times New Roman, 14, Bold. Subtitles: Times New Roman, 12, Bold.
- All figures, tables and photos must be clear and sharp. Please note that all figures, tables and photos will be printed in black and white.
- Quotations must be made through footnotes or endnotes. Quotations from books should be made as follows: Author's name, Title of the book, Place of publication, Publishing house, year, page(s). Example: McGhee, Patrick, „*The Academic Quality Handbook*”, Vancouver, London and Sterling, 2003, p. 163-164.
- Citations from articles should be made like this: Author's name, Title of the article, Title of the Journal, Number and/or date of issue, page(s). Example: Jeliaskova, Margarita, „*Systemic adaptation to a changing environment: Towards a next generation of quality assurance models.*”, *Higher Education*, Issue 3/4, Oct-Dec 2002, p433.
- The article should also include the bibliography at the end of the manuscript in alphabetical order of the authors' name.
