

## OPERATIONAL PLAN FOR 2019

The Operational Plan for 2019 translates ARACIS's strategic plan for 2018-2021 into short-term actions for 2019 and continues some activities started in 2018. The implementation of the Operational Plan involves ARACIS's human and financial resources. The activities are closely linked to the Agency's budget and to the strategic projects in which ARACIS participates as a coordinator or partner (e.g. university classification and study program ranking, doctoral assessment, equal opportunities or greater involvement of stakeholders in quality assurance processes).
