Papers are presented *in English language*.
No fee is charged for publishing papers.

To publish a paper in the QAR, please follow the steps below:

- send the paper (in editable and .pdf format), drafted as per the requirements below, to qar@aracis.ro,
- submit a Personal Statement on the originality of the paper, signed by all authors (*in .pdf format*), (as per *Annex 1*).
- submit the Correspondence Delegation Declaration signed by all authors (*in .pdf format*), (as per *Annex 2*).



- d) the editors will notify the *author* appointed for correspondence purposes about the reception of the paper, the approximate date by which the review is going to be performed, and the result of the review.

Paper drafting requirements (mandatory) <http://www.aracis.ro/instructiuni-pentru-autori-revista-qar/>:

1. The papers submitted for publication must correspond to the recommended topics, and the author's view must be scientific and unbiased.
2. The papers submitted for publication may be drafted by the author in English language.
3. The papers submitted for publication must have 6 to 16 pages (including notes and bibliography). Larger manuscripts will be considered as well, but they may be published sequentially.
4. The papers submitted for publication must include a summary (followed by no more than six keywords of the paper). The summary must contain 100 - 150 words.
5. Body text: Times New Roman, size 12, justified, 1.5 lines. Headings: Times New Roman, size 14, Bold. Sub-headings: Times New Roman, size 12, Bold.
6. Entries in the bibliography list and quotations will be made according to the author-data-reference system of the Chicago Manual of Style (Edition 16).
