External Institutional Evaluation Report

Danubius International University

May 2025

I have prepared the report on the institutional evaluation of the Danubius International University (hereinafter, DIU) in my capacity as international expert of the ARACIS Evaluation mission that visited on-site this academic center. The Evaluation mission carried out its activities according to the program approved by Florin MIHAI, PhD (in his capacity as the Evaluation Director) and Steve O. MICHAEL, PhD (who is the DIU's Rector and CEO) (see Annex 1). The ARACIS Evaluation mission was made up by twelve persons, of which eight persons were involved in the DIU's institutional evaluation, and four persons focused on the assessment of specific undergraduate degree programs of Law, Accounting and Management Informatics, and Communication and Public Relations.

Thus, the ARACIS evaluation mission in charge with the institutional evaluation was made up by: Florin MIHAI, PhD (full professor, Bucharest University of Economic Studies) as the Evaluation director; Adriana GIURGIU, PhD (full professor, University of Oradea) as the Coordinator of the Institutional Committee; Ovidiu FOLCUT, PhD (full professor, Romanian-American University of Bucharest) as the representative of the Advisory Committee; Miron ZAPCIU (full professor, University POLITEHNICA of Bucharest) as expert of the Institutional Committee; Ioana Georgiana POPESCU (ARACIS technical secretary); Petru-Liviu BOURUC (students' representative, ANOSR, University of Bucharest); Diana-Ioana Ciubar (students' representative, UNSR, National University of Physical Education and Sports of Bucharest); and myself, Gabriela Alexandra OANTA OANTA, PhD (full professor of public international law and international relations at the University of A Coruña (Spain), and Holder of the Jean Monnet Chair "European Union law of the oceans: New legal-maritime scenarios" (EUOLMS) co-financed by the European Union) as the international expert for the institutional evaluation. Additionally, the ARACIS evaluators in charge with the assessment of specific programs of studies were: for Law – learning on-site, Lucia IRINESCU, PhD (associate professor, "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" University of Iasi); for Accounting and Management Informatics – learning on-site, Daniel BOTEZ (full professor, "Vasile Alecsandri" University of Bacau); and for Communication and Public Relations – learning on-site, Alexandru CHIS, PhD (associate

professor, “Babes-Bolyai” University of Cluj-Napoca) and Ioan Petru DEAC (full professor, “Mihai Viteazul” National Intelligence Agency Academy of Bucharest). All the meetings were carried out on 21-23 May 2025 and took place at the venue of the DIU’s Rectorate as were scheduled by the ARACIS and the DIU.

Under the Article 2(2) of the civil agreement signed with the ARACIS for the DIU’s institutional evaluation, I had to use my own knowledge, skills and experience in order to prepare this report. I moreover used the qualitative and quantitative data available in the documents provided by the ARACIS and DIU, both before and during the on-site visit.

The DIU’s self-evaluation report on academic quality assurance at institutional level (hereinafter, the DIU’s institutional self-assessment report) and its annexes were especially useful for me to prepare the on-site evaluation visit. All of them were provided to me by the ARACIS well in advance. I also reviewed the documents, data, and information available on the DIU’s website both in Romanian (<https://univ-danubius.ro>) and in English (<https://univ-danubius.ro/en/>).

The on-site visit represented an excellent opportunity to enhance information I had received on the DIU and its activities before this visit. In this regard, mention should be made to the documents I asked for and received during the visit, which I have attached to this report as annexes 2-5. I consider all of them useful for supporting my evaluation.

As scheduled in the program of the evaluation mission, on 21-23 May 2025 I participated to various meetings with the DIU’s representatives, the academic staff, employers’ representatives, the teaching staff, the students, and the graduates of different studies at the DIU. Particularly fruitful and useful for gathering additional information and clarifications on the international dimension of the DIU’s activities and the research activities of the DIU’s teaching staff were the meetings and discussions with Emanuel Marinescu, who is the Head of Foreign Affairs within the DIU, and with Florian Nuta, who is the DIU’s Vice-Rector for Scientific Research and Creative Scholarship. The ARACIS evaluation mission ended with the meeting of its components with various representatives of this University.

I would like to thank Professors Florin Mihai and Adriana Giurgiu for the way they handled the evaluation mission as well as all the other colleagues for their fruitful talks held over those days. A special thanks goes to Ms. Ioana Popescu for her support from the very beginning, when I was invited to join this team, and for the technical support before, during and after the on-site visit of the DIU. Their valuable contributions to the smooth running of the meetings and the collaboration with the DIU is noteworthy.

I would also like to thank the DIU’s Rector and CEO, prof. Steve O. Michael, as well as his team for their hospitality, their availability for answering to all my questions, and for providing

me the requested information in due time.

From an institutional perspective, I would like to mention that the DIU was created in 1992 (see Annex 1 of the DIU's self-assessment report) under the Civil Court Decision no. 63/1992 of the Galati Court. At that time, its official name was "Romanian-American University Galati". In 1993 this name was changed to "'Anghel Rugina" Romanian-American University Galati". Based on the ARACIS's proposal, in 1996 the official name of this university started to be "'Anghel Rugina" University of Galati", which was changed to "Danubius University of Galati" in 1999. This University was accredited by Law no. 409 of 20 June 2002. Since 3 June 2024, the official name of this academic entity is "Danubius International University" (see also Annex 2 of the DIU's self-assessment report). The ARACIS granted the "Confidence" qualification to the DIU in two occasions so far, namely in 2013 and in 2019.

At present, the DIU counts on four faculties, namely: the Faculty of Law, the Faculty of Economic Sciences and Business Administration, the Faculty of Communication and International Relations, and the Faculty of Behavioral and Applied Sciences. They offer 25 study programs, of which 16 are at undergraduate level and nine are master's programs.

In addition, since 2018, there is the Department of Teacher Training and Education (hereinafter, DTTE). The DIU's self-assessment report states that this department operates as an autonomous university structure, which depends directly on the DIU's Rector (see p. 4). However, according to the existing organization chart (see Annex 5 of the self-assessment report), which was approved by the DIU's Senate on 16 December 2022 and entered into force on 10 January 2023, the DTTE is under the responsibility of the Vice-Rector for Teaching Activity.

According to the current organization chart (2022), the Danubius College [in Romanian: "Colegiul Danubius], the Department for Distance and Reduced Frequency Learning, and the Centre for Continuing Training and Technological Information are under the direction of the Vice-Rector for Teaching Activity. No reference to these bodies was included into the DIU's self-assessment report, however some information on them can be found on the DIU's website (<https://univ-danubius.ro/en/>).

It is worth mentioning that the DIU counts on several centres of research, which are under the responsibility of the DIU's Vice-Rector for Scientific Research and Innovation. Thus, the current organization chart (2022) states that there are four such centers, namely: the Research Center on Socio-Economic Dynamics in Sustainable Development, the Danubian Studies and Research Center, the Research Center "Theoretical and Applied Economics", and the Hermeneutics Center "Symbols and Texts". However, the DIU's self-assessment report contains references only to three of these centers (see p. 28). No reference is therefore made to the Research Center "Theoretical and Applied Economics". In addition, the two

versions (Romanian and English) of the DIU's website contain different information when it comes to research centers.

One of the most positive aspects I was able to see during the meetings held on 21 and 22 May 2025 concerns the important relationship that – I can say – exists between the students and the teaching staff, and which continues even after the end of the studies. This allows me to affirm that the DIU has benefited and benefits from the human element, being it constituted by its representatives, the students, the members of teaching staff, and the business companies and public bodies that host the DIU's students on internships or which hire DIU's alumni.

Under this context, in the coming paragraphs, I would like to point out a series of aspects that I consider that the DIU should work on in order to improve its situation on the Romanian university landscape and also as a part of the European Higher Education Area. In this regard, I will make a series of *comments* and *recommendations* that I believe could benefit the DIU in its future activity. They refer, on the one hand, to the internationalization activity of this University and, on the other hand, to the teaching staff's research activity and involvement in research projects.

Regarding *the DIU's internationalization activity*, a distinction has to be made between the international cooperation agreements, on the one hand, and the inter-institutional agreements, on the other hand. In both cases, the DIU has an outstanding number of agreements signed with universities from all over the world. Thus, the DIU has signed 82 international cooperation agreements with universities from 36 states, e.g.: Albania, Azerbaijan, Bangladesh, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brunei, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Chile, China, Philippines, France, Georgia, Germany, Greece, India, Indonesia, Iran, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Moldova, Morocco, Nigeria, Pakistan, Poland, Romania, Russian Federation, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Taiwan, Thailand, Turkey, Ukraine, and the United States of America. The vast majority of them have been signed before the pandemic COVID-19. Additionally, the DIU is affiliated to three international organizations, namely: the Association for the Global Advancement of Universities and Colleges (AGAUC) since 2011, the Association of Universities of Asia and the Pacific (AU AP) since 2014, and the International Association of Universities (IAU) since 2017. See Annex 32 of the self-assessment report.

At present, the DIU counts on 39 active inter-institutional agreements signed under the framework of Erasmus+ program with universities from 16 states, namely: Albania, Azerbaijan, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Greece, Hungary, Israel, Italy, Lithuania, Moldova, Poland, Portugal, the Russian Federation, Slovakia, Spain, and Turkey (see Annex 2 of my report).<sup>1</sup>

This conventional activity has enabled not only the students, but also the teaching staff to undertake numerous Erasmus+ mobilities. Thus, 50 students benefited from Erasmus+ mobilities, and numerous STA and STT mobilities were made by the DIU's teaching staff in universities from Albania (in 2020-2024), Bulgaria (in 2020 and 2022-2024), Czech Republic (in 2024), Greece (in 2022-2024), Italy (in 2022 and 2023), Israel (in 2021 and 2022), Moldova (in 2020-2024), Slovakia (in 2022-2024), Spain (in 2022), Thailand (in 2022-2024), and Turkey (in 2021-2024). At the same time, the DIU presents itself as an attractive university centre for the arrival of professors and administrative and service staff (STA and STT mobilities incoming) from different universities from Albania, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Israel, Italy, Latvia, Moldova, Spain, and Turkey (see Annex 108 of the self-assessment report and Annex 3 of my report).

During the meetings with the students and university professors, I highly appreciated their interests in such mobilities as well as their willingness to be more active in this field in the coming years.

The program for the awarding of *Doctor Honoris Causa* title represents another way to internationalize the DIU's activity. In this regard, the last event was held on 19 November 2019 when Vasile Soare, in his capacity as Romania's Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary Ambassador to the Russian Federation, received such a distinction (<https://univ-danubius.ro/images/danubius/dhc/brosura-dhc-vasile-soare.pdf>).

I highly appreciated that the DIU hosts the Jean Monnet Module "Research and Education for European Climate-neutral Economic Growth" (EU-CLING), which is co-financed by the European Union (<https://www.univ-danubius.ro/eu-cling-research-and-education-for-european-climate-neutral-economic-growth>) and coordinated by Florian Nuta, who is the DIU's Vice-Rector for Scientific Research and Creative Scholarship. Every year there is a very strong competition for the European Union's funding from such modules that focus on European Union studies. This module undoubtedly gives a higher visibility to the DIU's international activity and, through its teaching and research activities, gives the possibility to the DIU's teaching staff to collaborate with university professors from other academic centers and to offer the DIU's students a better training on the European Union issues.

This dynamism contrasts, however, with the current *teaching staff's research activity and involvement in international research projects*. The DIU's self-assessment report and its annexes, and the documents that were provided to me during the on-site visit allow me to affirm that there is much room for improvement in this field.

At the same time, I consider that this situation can be positively changed. From the meetings

with the Rector, the Vice-Rector for Scientific Research and Creative Scholarship, and the teaching staff of this University I was able to see their real interest in increasing their scientific output as well as their openness to the collaboration with foreign research groups. In relation to it, I would like to mention that, in the last five years, six articles were published in very good indexed reviews, one university professor benefited from an international fellowship, and three university professors were invited as speakers to international conferences abroad (see Annex 4 of my report).

I am confident that the state of play of the research activity in the DIU will be soon improved. From different meetings I had during the on-site visit and especially thanks to the meeting with the DIU's teaching staff on 22 May 2025, I could appreciate the willingness of the teaching staff to open up to collaborations with professors and research groups from universities with which the DIU has collaboration agreements. It is interesting to point out that various university professors affirmed that the DIU had offered its financial support to such scientific activities.

Another positive activity that can positively influence in this regard is the organization of international scientific conferences that the DIU organized in the last years. Thus, since 2021, five such academic events were held at the DIU's venue, namely: "Two Democratic Societies in Transition Exploring the Dynamics of a Post-Covid World" on 13-15 September 2021, the National Conference with International Participation "Theoretical and best practice in psychology" on 1-5 June 2022, International Conference "Circular Economy: Opportunities and Challenges 2022" on 17-18 November 2022, "Integration and Innovation: International Conference on Language Services and Foreign Studies in the Digital Age" on 24-26 October 2024, and the International Conference "European Integration – Realities and Perspectives. Events and Crises Reshaping the World in the 21st century" on 16-17 May 2025. Other two international conference will be taking place to the DIU's venue in the coming months. I would also like to underline that, from September 2022 to February 2026, the DIU is a partner of the network on the project "Improving the Resilience of Inland Waterways against Climate Change" (acronym: PLOTO; reference: HORIZON-CL5-2021-D6-01-09), which is co-funded by the European Union's Horizon Europe Innovation Actions. This project can represent an excellent opportunity for the DIU to increase its visibility and scientific outputs. So far, two scientific articles were published by prestigious and well-known reviews, such as *Sustainability* and *Inventions* (see Annex 35 of the self-assessment report and Annex 5 of my report).

On the basis of all these considerations, I would like to recommend to the DIU:

- To increase the number of scientific outputs published each year in journals indexed in SCOPUS and in Web of Science.

- To increase the number of books and of book chapters published by prestigious editorial houses that are taking into account by the Romanian Agency for Quality Assurance in Higher Education (in Romanian, ARACIS), and the National Commission for Attestation of University Degrees, Diplomas and Certificates from Romania (in Romanian, CNATDCU).
- To increase the number of the Jean Monnet actions  
(see: <https://erasmus-plus.ec.europa.eu/hr/programme-guide/part-b/jean-monnet-actions>).
- To present project proposals for the calls that are available on the European Union's platform of Funding & tender opportunities  
(see: <webgate.acceptance.ec.europa.eu/sedia/portal/screen/home>).
- To participate in other European Union's networks, such as those that look for the creation of real European universities that share common values and have the same teaching and research aims.
- To participate to the EU Careers Student Ambassadors Program (the information in English may be accessed at: [https://eu-careers.europa.eu/en/eu-careers/eu\\_careers\\_student\\_ambassadors](https://eu-careers.europa.eu/en/eu-careers/eu_careers_student_ambassadors); the information in Romanian is available at: [https://eu-careers.europa.eu/ro/eu-careers/eu\\_careers\\_student\\_ambassadors](https://eu-careers.europa.eu/ro/eu-careers/eu_careers_student_ambassadors)). I consider that this program will give a better visibility to the DIU at national, regional and international level, on the one hand, and will represent a very strong attraction for the DIU's students. The Romanian participating universities for the academic year 2024-2025 are as follows: Transylvania University of Brasov, "Vasile Goldis" Western University of Arad, "Stefan cel Mare" University of Suceava (Faculty of Law and Administrative Sciences), "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" University of Iasi, and National University of Political Studies and Public Administration (SNSPA). So far, it is known that next academic year the Romanian University System will be represented in this program by four universities, e.g.: University of Bucharest (Faculty of Business and Administration), "Stefan cel Mare" University of Suceava, "Transylvania" University of Brasov, and "Vasile Goldis" Western University of Arad.
- To increase the DIU's transparency on the financial support for its teaching staff. In this regard, information on the financial support offered to its teaching staff to participate in international conferences, to translate scientific articles to be published by journals internationally indexed, etc., could be published periodically on the DIU's website.
- To participate in the evaluation of the Romanian research organizations, which, according to the provisions of Government decision no. 138/2024, will start on 2 June 2025, and will be conducted by the National Research Authority from Romania [in Romanian, Autoritatea Nationala pentru Cercetare]. This evaluation will be a key aspect for being able to continue participating in project competitions under the National Research, Development and Innovation Plan of Romania.
